Welcome and Introductions

• Update on on-going projects-

 - The SHAC would also like to draft a letter to the SISD Board of Trustees and district administration requesting that bottle fill stations be included as a standard in all locations where fountains are installed. The SHAC is thankful for the support that the district maintenance department has provided and would like to see fountains install everywhere.

• Discussion on new projects-

- Trason reported that he would plan to attend several of the summer feedings in Park West this summer to represent the SHAC. Trason invited others to join him. He will communicate further about dates and times this summer.

The class titled Mental Health First-Aid is offered on May 18th and June 8th at the TLU campus in the ELCA Synod offices.
