- Welcome and Introductions
 - Mark Dibble called the meeting to order 5:33.

- Update on on-going projects-
 - Mark asked for an approval of the May meeting minutes. All SHAC members approved the minutes as written.

 - The Covid-19 dashboard on the district website has been updated to include positivity rates.
 - Dr. Gutierrez announced a new 3-tier threshold plan based on positivity rates. These

 - Safe Routes to School (Further discussion needed)
 - Michele Meehan shared that the Guadalupe County Child Advocacy center is seeing a rise in suicide attempts and ideation. Michele asked the district to increase training and distribution of resources related to suicide prevention.
