2017 State Tournament Results

For the 12th time, 11 in succession Seguin ISD will send some of our best and brightest students to showcase their creative and critical thinking skills at the Global Competition in Knoxville, May 24 - 27.

Since 2004 SISD will now have sent 36 teams to compete at the world level.

Of the 31 teams that have gone before

- 32% (10 teams) placed in the top three
- 65% (20 teams) placed in the top ten
- •81% (25 teams) placed in the top 15

The Texas competition was attended by almost 500 teams, the largest one day DI tournament in the world. Each SISD team competed against 20+ teams to earn the opportunity to compete against the best teams in the world. Five SISD teams are moving on!

Two teams earned The RENAISSANCE Award Criteria: outstanding skill in the areas of design, engineering, execution and performance.

- For the almost 500 teams less than 10 were deemed worthy.
- Both of these teams also earned the Renaissance at our regional tournament!!
